Please note that requirements listed in both fall and spring semesters can be completed any time during that school year.

First Year

Fall Semester

<u>Courses:</u> General Education, Curriculum Courses <u>Licensure:</u> Meet with general LAS advisor Declare "Teaching of ..." Major Pass Initial Licensure Exam^

Second Year

Fall Semester <u>Courses:</u> ED 200, ED 210 <u>Licensure:</u> Meet with program advisor Apply for Candidacy (*After completing 45-60 credit hours*) Complete CPS Field Experience Process

Third Year

<u>Courses:</u> SPED 410, Cl 414*, Methods Courses** <u>Licensure:</u> Meet with program advisor Pass Content Area Test^^ Begin completing field experience hours

Fourth Year

Fall Semester <u>Courses:</u> ED 425, Methods Courses** <u>Licensure:</u> Meet with program advisor Complete CPS Student Teaching Registration Process Complete Teacher Safety Education Module Finish completing required field experience hours

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Spring Semester

<u>Courses:</u> General Education, Curriculum Courses <u>Licensure:</u> Meet with program advisor Declare "Teaching of ..." Major Pass Initial Licensure Exam^

Spring Semester

Spring Semester

<u>Courses:</u> SPED 410, CI 414*, Methods Courses** Complete major and general education coursework <u>Licensure:</u> Meet with program advisor Pass Content Area Test^^ Request ED 425 Approval Complete FERPA and Mandated Reporter Training Complete CTE Student Teaching Application

Spring Semester

<u>Courses:</u> Complete Student Teaching <u>Licensure:</u> Meet with program advisor Apply for graduation Complete edTPA Complete Entitlement Application Complete Exit & Tech Survey Apply for licensure (*After your degree has been awarded*) * CI 414 is only required for some programs. Check with your program advisor for more details.

** Each program has specific methods course requirements. Check with your program advisor for more details.

^ Initial Licensure Exam (Test of Academic Proficiency, SAT, or ACT) passing score is required to be admitted to candidacy. Submit passing scores to CTE. Exam information can be found on the CTE website.
